**BASIS, RATES, AND BILLING**

**DUES ASSESSMENT** of “Industry Consumer: Chip Mill” members is based on the consumption of all wood fiber as it enters the member's company manufacturing processes for the preceding calendar year. Consumption is reported in January of each year in green short (2000-pound) tons.

**RATES** for Industry Consumer: Chip Mill members consuming wood fiber are based on the following table:
